Night Shelter

Staffed day and night by a dedicated team of project workers, we run the only Shelter in central Wales, aimed at providing safe accommodation for rough sleepers and homeless people. The project, funded by the Welsh Govt., aims to achieve positive resettlement outcomes through engagement with service users and by providing housing, finance and welfare support and signposting to specialist agencies.

Emergency Accommodation

The Care Society work closely with the Local Authority Housing team in providing temporary accommodation options for homeless people and families who fulfil the priority need criteria.



Tenancy Support

We provide tenancy support funded through Supporting People to enable homeless and potentially homeless people to acquire the skills and resources they need to sustain a tenancy and live as independently as possible. With a team based in Aberystwyth and Cardigan we cover the whole of Ceredigion. We offer advice and assistance to people in emergency accommodation, to single people, families and disabled people at home, along with young care leavers.

Befriending & Community Support

We offer help to people who have specific personal needs in order to help them maintain their independence or to feel part of their community. These can include complex social isolation issues, physical or mental conditions including learning disabilities like autism, chronic illness, and old age. Referrals come through Social Services or can be made directly to the Care Society by people who feel this service could benefit them.



Charity Shop

Like many charities, we rely on the generosity of the general public to sustain and enhance our services and provide extra for our service users. Our Charity Shop in Chalybeate Street, Aberystwyth takes adult and children's clothes, bric a brac and household items.
