Five years general working experience, or two years if you are a graduate.

Also eligible if you are retired or on a career break.

Become a mentor and inspire the next generation.

One Million Mentors (1MM) aims to give every young person in the country access to a trained mentor as they become adults. 1MM is a unique community-based mentoring programme, quickly growing roots around the UK. This ambitious scheme backs the talents of young people to improve their life chances, while at the same time strengthening local communities. 1MM was founded on the belief that through personal, one-to-one mentoring, more young people can grow the knowledge, networks, skills and con dence they need to succeed.

What does 1MM do?

We recruit, train and deploy people who are working, retired or on a career break, as mentors to work with youth partners in the community - such as schools, colleges, universities, youth groups, charities and employment initiatives. You are then matched to a local young person, through our online platform, who you will meet for one hour, once a month, for up to a year.

Mentors come from a range of backgrounds, the criteria being that you are working, retired, or on a career break, with 5 years of work experience, or at least 2 years if a graduate, and can commit to one hour, once a month for up to a year.

"You're going to have your eyes opened to what life is like for young people today. But you might also learn something about yourself. It's an all- round positive two-way experience and that's what I've agreed to continue doing it if there are mentees who want it."

How does it work?

1MM is accessible to anyone who has work experience and who is keen to get involved - no mentoring experience required. To ensure that all mentors start on their journey feeling fully prepared, mentors are required to complete the 1MM Mentor Training Programme, and will have access to online resources and support throughout the programme.

As part of the 1MM community, you will be offered the chance to attend additional workshops and network with other mentors in your area. Together, you will be making a lasting difference to young people across the UK

Why take part?

1MM's offer is changing lives, and the journey is exciting. Join us for social change on a national scale.

You can help raise the aspirations of local young people by supporting them with tasks such as writing job applications, making career choices, or by simply having a one-to-one conversation.

We know that our current mentors are motivated by their desire to:

- · Help young people be successful in their career
- · Be a role model for local young people,
- · Give back to their local community, and
- Develop their own personal skills many of our mentors say the skills learnt with 1MM are invaluable in their personal or work life.

As well as supporting young people to reach their ambitions, our research shows that 69% of 1MM mentors benefit from a sense of fulfilment and growth.

A. - 1MM Mentor Training Programme

☐ A1. Registration/ Login via Link: https://1mm.org.uk

Await approval, the 1MM team will typically process this within 7 days

- ☐ A2. Profile (10mins): Complete the profile section.
- ☐ A3. Training (90mins): Complete the online training 5-10min modules for busy professionals.
- □ A4. ★ Post-training survey (<5mins): A short survey for when the online training is completed, Submission will add you to the Mentor Workshop's priority invitation list. Link HERE.

*This stage is typically reached within 14days of account approval.

□ A5. Mentor Workshop (2hrs): One-time attendance only. An interactive group workshop, delivered online by an experienced facilitator to supplement the training. Sessions are offered each month, to practice core skills and inclusive also of a Q&A. *Invitations are sent out in the first week of every month.

Congratulations! You'll receive a Certificate of Achievement and be a fully trained 1MM Mentor.

B. - Matching & Mentoring

This typically takes 6-8wks, please be patient as it is driven by the young person's needs.

- ☐ **B1. Matching (young people will be 14-25yrs):** Your profile details will be used to align with the goals & ambitions of young people who have signed up for a mentor.

 B2. Mentor/ Mentee Induction only if a particular scheme requires it (45mins) There will be a group induction session if there is a partner involved who requests this.
- ☐ **B3. Mentoring:** Let the mentoring begin! 1hr sessions, monthly, for up to 12months.
- □ **B4.** ★ **End-mentoring evaluation**: At the end of each mentoring cycle which is 9-12months.


