WHAT IS THE CHAMPIONS NETWORK?

The Champions Network is part of Gwent BOOST, a new project for tackling homelessness in South Wales.

It is a network of people from the Private Rented Sector who are dedicated to addressing inequality and discrimination in renting.

Panel of representatives

We have a Tenant Panel and a Landlord Panel made up of people with experience of private renting. Each Panel meets every 6-8 weeks in community locations around Gwent. During the meetings, Panel members discuss the key equality issues in private renting, drawing on their own experience and expertise.

We then work together to produce information, guidance and training materials to support others in the sector. These materials are shared widely across the project's network.

Our Panels also have the chance to influence housing policy in Wales by contributing to Welsh Government consultations and focus groups. More information about this can be found here.

Forums and events

We run regular networking events for people in the Private Rented Sector. We host landlord and tenant forums, social lunches and community advice drop-ins. These are attended by tenants, landlords, and people who work with privately rented accommodation (such as council officers). These events are held all over South Wales, are free to attend and offer the chance to learn, network, socialise and access support or guidance. See what's coming up here.

Ongoing research

We listen and learn from the experiences of tenants and landlords all over Wales to continuously shape our work. We use a range of research methods such as direct interviewing, online surveys and data analysis to build a picture of the state of private renting.
